

Mountain View Golf Club Liquor Policy & Regulations



Mountain View Golf Club (MVGC) strictly adheres to all provisions of the Yukon territorial liquor licensing regulations. We are a fully licensed facility and wish to remain in good standing with the Yukon Liquor Corporation. We ask that you follow these policies and regulations while at MVGC. These policies and regulations are required to adhere to the terms of the Mountain View Golf Club's insurance policy.

Alcoholic beverages will be served in a responsible and professional manner at all times while continuing to provide this service for the enjoyment of all members and guests. All laws and regulations will be followed as they pertain to the service of alcohol to underage or visibly intoxicated persons. No person will be served alcohol if our staff deem they are intoxicated. We strive for everyone to have a safe and enjoyable experience while at the Mountain View Golf Club.

No alcoholic beverages other than those provided by the MVGC are permitted anywhere on the premises. We reserve the right to remove any person who violates this, without any refund being issued. If they fail to remove themselves, the RCMP will be contacted as the person/people in question would be putting our staff in danger.

A maximum of 3 alcoholic drinks will be allowed for purchase per person. If you are purchasing drinks for people in your group that exceeds the 3 allowed, we ask that they come into the proshop or to the beverage cart to pick them up themselves.

Further, the Mountain View Golf Club, and its staff advise the following:

- Service will not be provided to patrons who are intoxicated, fighting, using profane/abusive language or are misusing or destroying property.
- Members and guests who are denied service can remain on the premises, unless they have been asked to leave. If they are asked to leave, MVGC can assist in securing appropriate transportation.
- Please advise MVGC staff if you plan to leave your vehicle on site overnight. The gate is locked every evening.
- If members or guests have denied MVGC's assistance in securing appropriate transportation, and choose to drive off the grounds while under the influence of alcohol, the RCMP will be contacted with the description of your vehicle. Please choose the responsible decision, for both yourself and others on the road.
